

All India IPSC Yoga Championship 2025 Hosted by The Rajkumar College, Rajkot

The All India IPSC Yoga Championship 2025 was successfully hosted by The Rajkumar College, Rajkot, from 13th to 15th October 2025. The event saw remarkable participation with 17 schools from across India competing in various categories and events.
